Road Tolls



Take advantage of the free tolls on the new EastLink Freeway opening Sunday 29th June.

EastLink runs between Donvale in Melbourne's north east, through Dandenong, to Frankston in the south-east of Melbourne. Around 40% of Melburnians live in this corridor, which includes important retail, commercial and industrial centres.

The 39 kilometre motorway includes 17 easy-to-use intersections, which provide access to major roads and suburbs along its length.



VISITING MELBOURNE

To travel on CityLink you may purchase a pass prior to travelling or up to midnight three days after travel.

You can choose from:

24 Hour pass: Unlimited travel between Bulla Rd and Flemington Rd only, for a 24hr period from your first trip.

Tulla Pass: Unlimited travel between Bulla Road and Flemington Road only, for a 24 hour period from your first trip.

Weekend Pass: Unlimited access from midday Friday to midnight Sunday.

You can purchase your pass:

on the CityLink website - to purchase a pass, over the counter at Victorian Australia Post outlets; at selected newsagencies using the Touch over-the-counter or Bill Express payment systems; via Bill Express kiosks at major Coles Express outlets; or by calling 13 26 29.
